Class Descriptions and Schedule

Kathleen Fallon - Songs You Want to Sing Again (Levels 1-3) Saturday, 10:15-11:30

Every new song is just a friend you haven't met yet! In this repertoire class you'll get to explore some songs that you might not know, and once you hear them I'll bet you'll want to sing them again! I'll share the zoom screen with lyrics and chords for each song so you can play and sing along. The chords will be for guitar, but every instrument is welcome. Bring your voices and instruments and prepare to have some fun!

Janet Peterson - Beyond Beginning Guitar: You've got the basics (Level 2) Saturday, 11:45-1:00 You know some chords and can switch between chord easily... most of the time. We will find some new and exciting chords to expand your list, delve into finger picking, some strumming rhythms that spice things up, and maybe even flat picking, AND as an added bonus I'll show you ways of practicing that makes this all really fun! This class may lead to you writing a song by accident of practicing, Bring your inner teenager!

Ellen Wolfson - Introduction to Storytelling (Level 1) Saturday, 1:30-2:45 Our lives are made of stories connecting us to others, allowing us to laugh, cry and create memories. In this class we will learn about the craft of storytelling by looking at our own stories through a variety of exercises. No previous experience with storytelling required – just a willingness to have fun.

Nan Collie - Beginning Harmonica (Level 1) Saturday, 3:00-4:15 Lets play! In this workshop you'll learn to how to hold the harmonica, how to get vibrato, and even how to get that elusive single note so you can begin to play songs. We'll play some tunes and have a great time with this accessible, portable little instrument.

Marie Eaton - Songwriting: Song Seeds (Levels 1-3) Friday, 7-8 p.m. and Sunday, 9:45-11:15 Do you write tunes, but can't find the words? Do you write words but need help to find your melodies? Have you got ideas but just haven't written anything recently? Are you longing to write a song, but just never put pen to paper long enough?

This class will have two sessions (but you don't have to come to both). In the first class ([Friday, 7-8 p.m.](#)) we're going to do a couple of writing exercises to jump-start lyric and melody writing. Everyone is welcome. Guaranteed, you'll end the session with a song-seed planted!

In the second session, ([Sunday, 9:45-11:15](#)) 8-10 students will sign up in advance to have the chance to bring a song in progress for some gentle guidance and polishing. Others are welcome to come listen and learn.

Rene' Zingarelli - Paper Weaving - Creating Delightful Designs (Levels 1-3) Sunday,

11:30-12:45 Using only a few common supplies from home, learn the simple art of weaving paper into interesting patterns and shapes. Let your creative self have some fun! No experience needed.

Linda Vogt - Beyond Beginning Ukulele: Discovering Melodies (Level 2) Sunday, 1:15-2:30 The ukulele is a sweet and versatile instrument. Would you like to be able to fingerpick a simple tune or two? We will warm up by playing chords and doing some singing, then we will learn the notes in the key of C and play some familiar melodies using just those notes. Expand your ukulele horizons!
